- 1. More signs of revival on the continent of Europe. Events will take place which will have a humbling effect on the people of the continent, and it will, in turn, lead to uncertainty that will, in turn, lead to a door for God's Spirit and revival. France, Spain, Belgium, and many other European nations are standing on the thresholds of revival. It looks like it will spread from the south to the north of Europe.
- 2. Signs of revival in Sweden will be seen mostly among the young people and immigrants. The old Swedish concept of the "prayer meeting" must be restored and re-instituted in more Churches, for God to be able to move and bless the land of Sweden. With more prayer, the Islands of the west coast could see revival, but Sweden will also be shaken by unexpected problems. When all are saying everything is fine, sudden destruction will hit the land, but those that pray for the land of Israel and support anointed world evangelistic missions, will increase and be blessed.
- 3. United States remains under judgment and will see great scandals in the government, but the economy will do better than expected. The president's honey-moon will come to an end. Strange weather patterns will continue, but less so than in 2012. The revival will grow as more people are seeking God.
- 4. Latin America will see greater revival than ever as God pours out an anointing of great signs and wonders.

 This will come as a result of the fear of the Lord being restored in the churches with a greater respect for his presence and for his anointed servants. (Acts 2:43, Acts 5:11-12) It will continue to affect the Hispanic Churches in the U.S. and will also spill over into the Anglo Churches, as the fire moves north.
- 5. Israel will go into a very dangerous war with Iran and its other neighbors, and the Arab spring will turn to winter. It can be stopped, but only by the prayers of God's people. Pray for the peace of Jerusalem, they shall prosper that love thee. (Psalm 122:6)
- 6. The Spirit of government reliance will grow weaker in U.S.A. and Europe, as it becomes more evident how limited the federal government is in its ability to help its people, in times of financial crisis and natural disasters.
- 7. More Muslims in the U.S. will be converted as they have visions and dreams in which the Lord Jesus appears to them. Literally, millions of Muslims will come to the faith in the Middle East and around the world.
- 8. The Lord says that he has not forgotten the sons of Ishmael, who are also the sons of Abraham, but that he is visiting them and calling them to unite with their brothers, the sons of Isaac. He is also calling the adopted sons of Abraham (the Church), to unite with both Isaac and Ishmael. The UNIFICATION of these three groups in Christ, all from the seed of Abraham, will release an unstoppable force of the glory of God that will help to bring in great wealth, and also a multitude of souls, into the Kingdom of God. A threefold cord is not quickly broken. (Ecclesiastes 4:12)
- 9. The move of God in North Korea will grow as escaped North Koreans continue to evangelize their land through radio, secret messengers, and other means. *The strongman of North Korea is growing weaker as a result of the prayers of God's people.*
- 10. Angelic activity will increase and miracles, only seen in the developing countries, will begin to be seen also in the industrialized world, as even dead will be raised.
- 11. New revelations from the Kingdom of God will come to the church and will open for great blessings, but they will also create great controversy and persecutions. God's apostolic order will be restored in many churches, and many in the *"paganized" Church* will discover and return to the Jewish roots of the early Church.
- 12. The apostate Church will be upstaged by the living Bride of Christ. This will take place as the Glory of God grows and is revealed through the Body of Christ in a mighty increase of the operations and manifestations of the sons of God. (Romans 8:18-19)
